Winter Fuel Payment Terms and Conditions

- The Barrhill Community Interest Company's annual Winter Fuel Payment is for permanent residents of the District of Barrhill Community Council only
- Applicants must be a resident, homeowner or tenant at the property on a permanent basis
- The property for which the Winter Fuel Payment is being claimed must be the individuals' main residence
- Documentary proof of main residence status is required by the submission of a current South Ayrshire Council Council Tax Notice and one other document of the applicant's choice to substantiate main residence status (originals only – will be returned to applicant)
- Only one individual per property may apply for the Winter Fuel Payment
- By completing and signing the Winter Fuel Payment Application Form the individual understands that the information given on the form will be used to check eligibility to receive the BCIC Winter Fuel Payment
- By completing and signing the Winter Fuel Payment Application Form the individual understands that any fraudulent claims for a Winter Fuel Payment will be pursued with vigour, up to and including the law where necessary.
- Should it be determined at any stage following payment that a fraudulent claim has been made, then the individual may be required to refund all payments made and will be barred from subsequent applications to the BCIC for any grants or bursaries.
